### **FINANCIAL POLICY STATEMENT**

It is our policy to bill your insurance carrier or other provider of medical benefits as a courtesy to you, although you are responsible for the entire bill when the services are rendered. Required co-payments and estimated co-insurances are to be made as services are rendered and arrangements are to be made for payment of all amounts not covered by your medical benefits or estimated co-insurances as soon as those amounts are known. If you fail to make timely payment for any amount for which you are responsible, you will be responsible for all costs of collection, including court costs, collection agency fees and/or a reasonable attorney fee.
